It will enable the Regiment to:

- Support the families of those killed in action by promptly responding to problems of bereavement and hardship.
- Support those wounded or injured on operations, particularly those who have had to leave the Army; to assist in finding them new employment and to help them become active family and community members.

- Support the families of those seriously wounded or injured in prolonged recovery situations.

THE HIGH SHERIFF'S FUND

High Sheriffs are active in supporting charities and voluntary services. There is a particular emphasis on crime reduction and the development of an anti-crime culture. This covers a very wide range of initiatives run by local charities and voluntary groups.

To this end, the High Sheriff's Fund was established in 1995 to make possible the permanent funding of Awards for exceptional achievement in the prevention of crime and the provision of useful and rewarding activities for young people. The Fund has grown steadily since its creation and makes many awards each year.
